Pennsylvania Counseling Services (PCS) offers a full-time 12-month Doctoral Internship in Health Service Psychology. The primary method of training is experiential and includes opportunities to provide clinical services to a wide variety of clientele from culturally and socioeconomically diverse backgrounds. A central feature of the PCS internship is its emphasis on provision of psychological services tailored to meet the needs of underserved populations, with interns providing individual and group treatment for individuals with mental health and substance use disorders across the lifespan within an outpatient setting.
