WOMEN'S BEHAVIORAL HEALTH CLINIC (DAUPHIN)

The Women's Clinic at our Harrisburg outpatient location offers specialized outpatient psychiatric treatment for life's challenges and changes.

TRIPLE P PARENTING PROGRAM (DAUPHIN)

Triple P offers parenting classes and counseling at our 17th Street location.

TMS THERAPY FOR DEPRESSION (BERKS-WYOMISSING OP)

Transcranial magnetic stimulation (TMS) is a noninvasive nerve stimulation therapy offered to improve symptoms of severe depression.

RECOVERY SERVICES

RECOVERY SUPPORT & CASE MANAGEMENT SERVICES

Our services connect clients with local resources as well as employment assistance, all of which helps guide them toward long-term recovery.

DAY REPORTING CENTER (LEBANON)

DRC services are provided in conjunction with adult probation to assist those involved in the criminal justice system with community reentry and building recovery skills.

SERVICES FOR CHILDREN & ADOLESCENTS

FAMILY-BASED THERAPY

Family-based therapy is a more intensive form of therapy for children and adolescents who are at risk of out-of-home placement. This service focuses on the entire family and is provided in their natural environment.

INTENSIVE BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES (IBHS)

IBHS includes individual services and applied behavior analysis (ABA) services for a child or young adult in their home, school, or community. Individual services provide intensive therapeutic interventions that support their needs, improve their skills, promote positive behaviors, and maximize their functioning ability. ABA services explore why certain behaviors occur and seek to increase useful or desired behaviors.

MULTISYSTEMIC THERAPY (JUVENILE JUSTICE)

MST is a more intensive form of therapy for adolescents who are involved in the juvenile justice system. This approach involves family members and takes place in their home and community.

CHECK & CONNECT (TRUANCY PREVENTION)

Check & Connect is an evidence-based truancy intervention/prevention program that partners a mentor with a student and family for a minimum of two years. For a list of schools that offer Check & Connect, please call the outpatient office in your county.
