#### MANAGEMENT SERVICES

Our services connect clients with local resources as well as employment assistance, all of which helps guide them toward long-term recovery.

#### DAY REPORTING CENTER (DRC) (LEBANON)

DRC services are provided in conjunction with adult probation to assist those involved in the criminal justice system with community reentry and building recovery skills.

#### FAMILY-BASED THERAPY

Family-based therapy is a more intensive form of therapy for children and adolescents who are at risk of out-of-home placement. #### INTENSIVE BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES (IBHS)

IBHS includes individual services and applied behavior analysis (ABA) services for a child or young adult in their home, school, or community. Individual services provide intensive therapeutic interventions that support their needs, improve their skills, promote positive behaviors, and maximize their functioning ability. ABA services explore why certain behaviors occur and seek to increase useful or desired behaviors.
