RECOVERY SERVICES

Recovery Support

Recovery support services assist clients building their road to recovery from substance use through temporary peer support to establish new long term support systems. We offer case management and Certified Recovery Specialist (CRS) services to connect clients with the resources they need and support their overall recovery.

Neonatal Abstinence Syndrome Prevention (NAS)

All services are free and include case management support for pregnant and postpartum women; assistance with resource coordination and tangible goods; and education on pregnancy prevention and safe sex. 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CHILDREN & ADOLESCENTS SERVICES

Family-Based Therapy

Family-based therapy is a more intensive form of therapy for children and adolescents who are at risk of out-of-home placement. This service focuses on the entire family and is provided in their natural environment.

Intensive Behavioral Health Services

IBHS includes individual services and applied behavior analysis (ABA) services for a child or young adult in their home, school, or community. Individual services provide intensive therapeutic interventions that support their needs, improve their skills, promote positive behaviors, and maximize their functioning ability. ABA services explore why certain behaviors occur and seek to increase useful or desired behaviors.
